Concept Note:

Objectives

The objectives of the workshop are:

- to enable participants to prepare research proposal;
- to introduce them to the importance of review of related literature;
- to acquaint them with various tools, sampling techniques and sources of data collection;
- to impart them knowledge about data processing, analysis and interpretation;
- to apprise them about research report writing;
- to familiarize them with referencing and reference writing and
- to enhance their skills in data entry and statistical analysis (MS-Excel and SPSS) as well as use of ICT tools.

About the Organisers:
