Students' Project:

Project on EDIBLE ARTHROPODS

A scientific approach for identification and documentation of Edible arthropods in Assam has been carried out by a group of 6th semester student, Dept. of Zoology, Dhakuakhana College.

Arthropods (phylum Arthropoda) any member of the phylum Arthropoda, the largest phylum of animal kingdom, which includes such familiar forms as Lobsters, Crabs, Spiders, Insects, Centipedes, Millipedes and Mites etc. About 80% of all known species of animals are member of this Phylum. Arthropods are adopted for life in air, water and land. They are free living, parasitic on plants, man and other animals. Some are gregarious. Arthropods are economically very important. Crabs, insects, lobsters, shrimps are eaten by man. The eggs, larvae, pupae and adults of certain insects have been eaten by men from prehistoric times to the present day. Around 3000 ethnic group practices entomophagy. Human entomophagy is common to culture in most parts of the world including Central and South America, Asia, Australia and Newzealand.

There are more than 200 edible insects recorded from NE India. A total of 92 different species belong to 9 orders and 29 families are consumed by Angamies of Nagaland. Entomophagy is also common practice among the ethnic people of Assam especially among the tribes of Dhemaji, Morigaon, Udalguri, Baksa and Karbi Anglong district and are closely associated with their culture. In Assam around 67 species of edible insects under 8 orders and 27 families are consumed. In Arunachal Pradesh 65 species of edible insects belonging to 9 orders and 24 families were reported. In Manipur about 69 species belong to 29 families and 9 orders are recorded. About 2000 different species of arthropods are eaten all over the World. The arthropods that are eaten the most are Butters, Wasps, Crickets, grasshoppers, different stages of silkworms. Most of the arthropods are good source of protein and fats.


PG Memorial Debate Competition


